We are proud to be one of the largest healthcare networks in South Texas with more than 260 physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners who offer primary care and a wide variety of specialty care services. All of our providers support their patients with vast experience, knowledge and talents. We are a critical part of our larger Baptist Health System network, connecting people of all ages and genders to the care they need, where and when they need it. We have worked diligently to bring exceptional primary care and specialty care services to our region, helping meet the growing demand for healthcare resources in our communities.

Baptist Medical Network's extensive primary care provider network serves as a strong foundation for all specialty care service lines. Our Women's Services providers care for patients across a full spectrum of needs – from routine checkups and labor and delivery to advanced minimally invasive robotic surgical procedures. Some specialized services include gynecology and advanced pelvic surgery, maternal-fetal care, gynecologic oncology, and urogynecology.

With 44 practices, more than 130 locations, in 23 communities, and across 12 counties, Baptist Medical Network providers cared for some 238,482 patients in 2025 alone. Our mission is to be the premier healthcare organization in South Texas by providing quality and compassionate care that exceeds our community's expectations. Our physician practices work in collaboration with our seven acute care hospitals, nine Baptist Neighborhood Hospitals, M&S imaging Centers, and Healthlink Rehabilitation Centers to provide a safety net of care that is available no matter where you live or work in South Texas. Obstetrics

From the earliest stages of pregnancy through labor and delivery, the Baptist Health System obstetrics team and Baptist Medical Network's OB/GYNs provide thoughtful, personalized care for both mother and baby. We're ready with 24/7 OB care, attentive patient navigators, care for high-risk pregnancies and access to high-level NICU care in our Level IV Neonatal Intensive Care Units (NICU).

While every birth at The Nest at Baptist Health System is unique, each share one thing in common: our staff's dedication to providing the best possible compassionate and personalized care for moms, their babies and their families.

We have a pregnancy care team in San Antonio, composed of OB/GYN doctors, nurses and staff, who are experienced in providing compassionate care to pregnant women and their babies regardless of where they are on the pregnancy timeline. Some of the prenatal services we offer include:

- ▶ Multiple OB/GYN doctors in San Antonio
- ▶ On-campus OB/GYN practices for convenience
- ▶ Specialized high-risk pregnancy care
- ▶ Pregnancy-related tests and screenings (i.e., transvaginal ultrasound, abdominal ultrasound, blood tests, etc.)

Baptist Medical Network offers maternal-fetal care providers who specialize in managing high-risk pregnancies. They receive advanced training and certification to care for patients with complex needs – from chronic health conditions, multiple gestation to maternal age over 35.

At Baptist Medical Network, preventive care is designed to support strong, healthy minds and bodies through every phase of life. Our dedicated team of OB/GYN specialists provides personalized wellness exams to help patients better understand their bodies, identify potential risk factors, and make informed, healthy decisions. Whether caring for young women, individuals starting a family, or those in the menopausal stage, our team is committed to providing guidance and support at every step – helping patients live long, healthy, and fulfilling lives.



Gynecology

We offer compassionate gynecological care, including minimally invasive gynecological surgery, for women in San Antonio and South Texas who have fertility, menstruation, hormone or other reproductive system concerns.

At Baptist Medical Network, we are determined to help women stay proactive with their health by providing a wide variety of high-quality gynecology services. We have board-certified gynecologists in San Antonio who diagnose, treat and manage different types of conditions related

to the female reproductive system, such as ovarian cysts, uterine fibroids, tumors and more. In addition to our gynecologists, our team includes nurses, technologists, and administrative staff who support patients throughout their care journey. We also have providers board-certified in minimally invasive gynecologic surgery to address surgical needs.

Whether experiencing signs of a particular condition, planning a gynecology exam, or seeking a second opinion, patients can access expert and compassionate care from our gynecologists in San Antonio. Our nurses, radiologists, and administrative staff are also available to provide support throughout the care journey – from the initial visit through recovery and return to optimal health. Some of the gynecologic services we offer at Baptist Medical Network include:

- ▶ Gynecology tests and screenings in various imaging centers
- ▶ Personalized care programs focused on patients unique needs
- ▶ Surgeons in a wide range of open and laparoscopic gynecological surgeries
- ▶ Minimally invasive robotic surgeries that may lead to less scarring, shorter hospital stays and faster recovery periods.

Gynecology Procedures and Conditions We Treat

Baptist Medical Network provides advanced treatment options for various gynecology conditions, such as (but are not limited to) the following:

- ▶ Bartholin's cysts
- ▶ Cervical dysplasia
- ▶ Cervical and uterine cancer
- ▶ Endometriosis
- ▶ Incompetent cervix
- ▶ Menorrhagia or excessive bleeding
- ▶ Ovarian cysts
- ▶ Ovarian tumors
- ▶ Pelvic inflammatory diseases
- ▶ Permanent sterilization procedures
- ▶ Radiofrequency ablation of fibroids (preserving uterus)
- ▶ Sexual dysfunction
- ▶ Sexually transmitted infections
- ▶ Transvaginal hysterectomy (no scars)
- ▶ Uterine fibroids
- ▶ Hormone replacement therapy

We understand that pelvic health conditions can impact every aspect of a woman's life – from physical comfort to emotional well-being. Our urogynecology and advanced pelvic surgery providers are dedicated to providing compassionate, highly specialized care for women experiencing complex pelvic floor disorders.

Our team offers comprehensive evaluation and treatment for conditions such as pelvic organ prolapse, urinary and fecal incontinence, and uterine fibroids. With a focus on minimally invasive techniques, we help patients achieve faster recovery times, less discomfort, and better long-term outcomes.

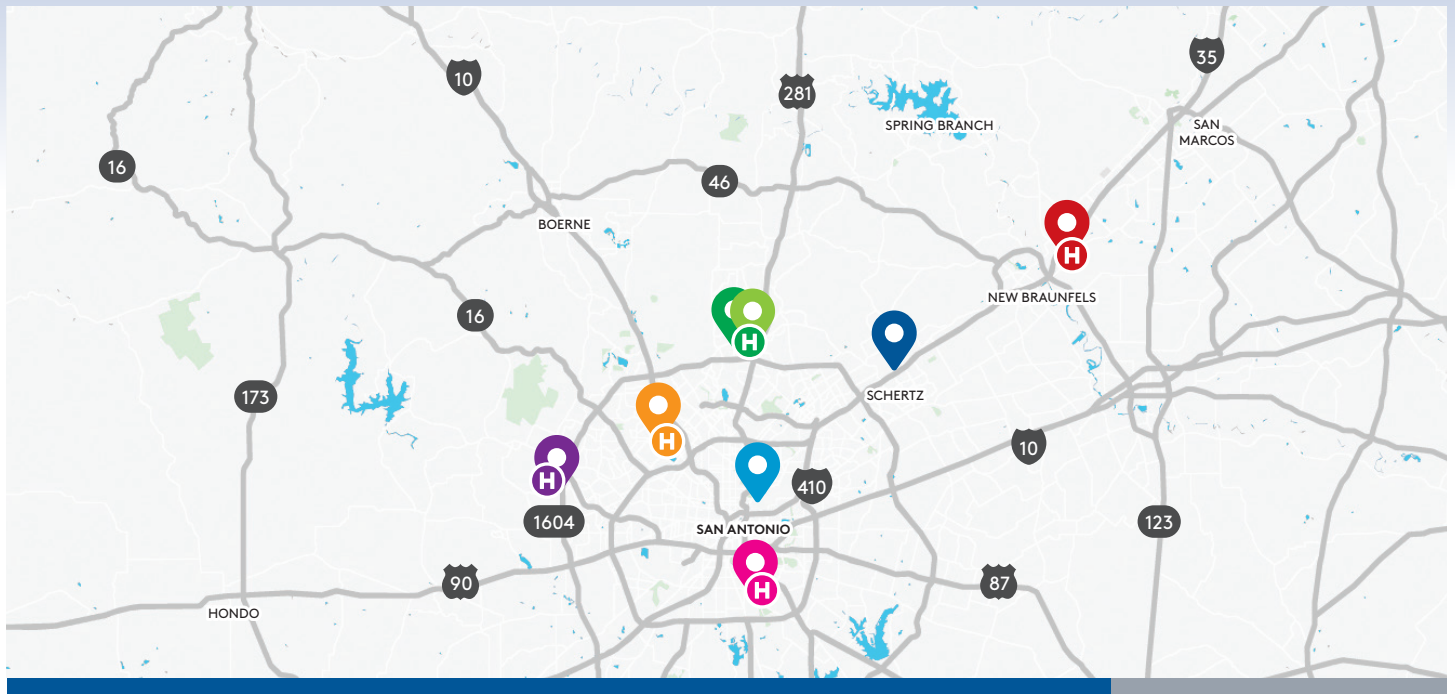

Urogynecology Procedures and Conditions We Treat

Baptist Medical Network provides advanced treatment options for various urogynecology conditions, such as (but are not limited to) the following:

- ▶ Transvaginal surgery with no incision
- ▶ Fibroid treatment options to preserve uterus
- ▶ Pelvic floor neuromuscular evaluation
- ▶ Pelvic floor reconstructive repair
- ▶ Minimally invasive technology
- ▶ Robotic surgery/single incision robotic surgery
- ▶ Urodynamic evaluation
- ▶ Urogynecology bladder control issues
- ▶ In-office cystoscopy
- ▶ Evaluation of possible mesh complications
- ▶ Sacral nerve stimulation
- ▶ Injections of bladder Botox
- ▶ Injections of urethral bulking agents
- ▶ Pelvic trigger point injections
- ▶ Pessary fitting and maintenance
- ▶ Surgery for pelvic organ prolapse
- ▶ Surgery for urinary incontinence

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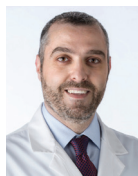
